Pastoral Letter from Chollerton Vicarage

As I write this, the richness of the colour of the autumn leaves is at its best, and leaves are now falling, as the nights draw in. The church season also changes as we come towards the close of the church year with the Kingdom Season which leads up to Advent and the new church year.

The Season begins with the days between November 1st and 11th which are a season of national remembering, when people move from thinking not only about personal losses, to remembering those who have died serving their country. During this strange year of the Covid-19 pandemic, and for us locally with the death of Steve our beloved Priest and Area Dean it will be an especially poignant time.

We know that we will not be able to have our usual Services of Remembrance because of Covid-19 restrictions, but this does not mean that we will not be remembering.

On November 1st we will celebrate All Saints Day. In addition, there will be a special online service for All Souls Day on November 2nd at 7.00pm, when we will pause and remember those whom we love but now see no longer. If you would like to join this and have not tried a Zoom service, do contact one of the clergy or church wardens.

On Remembrance Sunday, November 8th, the Zoom Remembrance Service will be shortened to allow people to hold their own two-minute silence at home when 11.00am comes, and also to allow those laying wreaths at Memorials to be there for 11.00am in the restricted numbers we are permitted.

Our lives are changing in so many ways, and we are in the process of having consultations as we discern the best way to be the people of God in this area. But what is not changing is the faithfulness and love of God for each of us. We watch and wait together in so many ways. God bless each of you as we journey on.
